Preface

These records are the legacy of our Yarbrough family researchers, to whom much is owed. The known family researchers include Jean Baker, Ann Y. Broadbent, Mary Y. Daniel, Frances (Rea) Donohue, Betty Humrighouse, Pauline Gray, Evelyn Goble, Nelle Morris Jenkins, Ophelia Kessler, Frances Lockwood, Karen Mazock Renee Smelley, Dorothy Svec, Jeanette Wilson, Cleveland "Cy" Yarbrough, Edna Yarbrough, George A. Yarbrough, and Robert Price Yarbrough.

The originals of these volumes are being kept for the benefit of future generations by the Williamson County Library, Franklin, Tennessee.

No claims of accuracy or authentication of the material herein are made or may be assumed. Many of these records have been superseded by subsequent research. Hence, there are records which are erroneous and unreliable; it would have been a Herculean task to attempt to correct all of them. Fortunately, there are only a few critical genealogical facts that are involved, and which are correctly stated here:

- Richard (the Immigrant) Yarborough was never married to Frances Proctor;
- Ambrose Yarbrough did not immigrant from Yorkshire; he is now believed to be a descendant of Richard the Immigrant;
- There are so far only two proven sons of Old Richard John and Richard II;
- There is so far no evidence proving Joshua Yarborough I to be a descendant of Old Richard.
- The "Old Country" referred to in old documents and letters is the Colony of Virginia, not England or the Old World.
- There were not seven brothers who immigrated from "the old country"; in fact, it now appears there were three brothers and four sons of the brothers. Which were the fathers and which were the sons are so far unknown.

In spite of these inaccuracies, these records comprise much of our history and some of our accomplishments. There are pages whose print quality is so poor that word recognition was not possible. In spite of that, at least partial capability for searching these volumes is provided, as well as an index to each volume. Nonetheless, the viewer is cautioned to perform his/her own due diligence in connection with any use of this material.

The various spellings of the Yarbrough surname have never been applied consistently, even within a given family. To the extent possible, the names in the index reflect the names used on the source pages; where it wasn't clear as to which might be the proper spelling, the spelling used is "Yarbrough".

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

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

Dear Mr. Allen,

Your name has been sent to me by several persons who are familiar with your book about the Allen Family. I have had the opportunity to read some of that, and must say you are to be congratulated for a most interesting family history.

My book will be an overview of the larger family, and will not have the interesting details which you have been able to incorporate into your history. It will contain as many dates and places as possible and will show the interrelationships which are very complex in those families who intermarried so frequently. I believe, and others agree, that my book will complement their own more intimate family histories.

I am still in the research stage, but hope to start putting things together later this year, and would like to ask for your permission to cite your work. I would also like to tell readers where they can read your book, or perhaps purchase a copy of it. I have not found it in the libraries in which I have worked. Can you tell me where it can be obtained?

My own research indicates that Robert Allen, the second of that name, probably born in New Kent County, Va. was the father of your Drewry Allen who married Elizabeth Yarbrough. Robert moved from Hanover County to Lunenburg County about 1746, bought and sold quite a lot of land there, and was in Amelia County, Va. from 1757 to 1761 where he owned land adjoining Henry Yarbrough, whose land adj. Samuel Yarbrough. In 1761, Henry and Martha Yarbrough moved to Granville County, and there he and Robert Allen owned land in the same vacinity. The area where they lived subsequently became Bute Co., then Franklin County. Robert sold out in 1781 and moved to Caswell County, apparently to be near his son, Drewry and his brother, Drury. Robert's will, dated in 1782, rec. 1784, left his home plantation to his grandson, Josiah Allen, son "of my son Drury."

Robert Allen had sons Young, Josiah, Robert and Drury. Young, Allen witnessed a deed in Lunenburg County, Va. in the spring of 1761, and purchased land in Johnston Co. about a month later. That land was later in Wake Co., and was only a few miles from his father's land in Granville County. Young died in 1774, Josiah was killed in S.C. during the retreat of Gen. Nathaniel Greene from the Siege of Ninety-Six. Both Young and Josiah named sons Young, Robert, Drury and Josiah. I think their younger brother, Drewry (Drury) used the same names for some of his sons, "and so on, and so on!"

The DAR records which give Samuel Yarbrough as the father of Elizabeth Yarbrough Allen are apparently incorrect. Henry Yarbrough was her father, and as I said earlier, Henry lived near the Allens in Va. and in N.C. Henry had sons Henry, Jr, and Charles, who were in Franklin County where Robert Allen lived from the time the county was formed until he moved to Caswell County in 1781. Stokes Allen was the executor of the estate of Charles Yarbrough, and he sold the part which was inherited by Charles'sister, Elizabeth and her husband Drury Allen, in 1816. Drury and Elizabeth were already in Greene County, Ga. at the time of that sale.

Stokes Allen and Young Drewry Allen were both married in Person County which was formed from part of Caswell County about 1790. Robert died while it was still Caswell County, but his brother, Drury Allen who lived quite nearby, was in the part which became Person County, so his will was recorded there. Robert and his brother, Drury, were quite old when they died, and several of their children died before their fathers.

Your book is a very big contribution to the preservation of Allen Family heritage and tradition, and I do hope it will be available to future family researchers. There is such little data in print about our Allens! I will appreciate it so much is you will give me permission to cite some of the text of your book, with due credit given, and with the source of that book for others to share.

My book will be strictly non-profit, and I do hope to get it on the shelves of quite a few of the genealogical libraries around the country, for whatever value it may have for others. And of course, it is a "joint" effort with many contributions from other descendants of Robert Allen.

Thanks for any help you can give. If you have "new" descendants whom you would like to have included, I will be glad to do so.

Brury Allen was born Dec. 1, 1749 in Lunenburg County, Virginia. He died testate on January 20, 1826 in Fike County, Georgia. Drury's wife, nee Elizabeth Yarbrough, was born May 2, 1752 in Amelia County, Virginia and she died in Fike County, Georgia on Feb. 20,1828. Drury and Elizabeth were both buried on their famm near Zebulon, Georgia. The graves are marked with tombstones which give the dates of their births and deaths.

There are NO tombstones of this description in this eemetery. The Beorgia State archives show this to be a fact and recorded in 1976. I have been living all my life close to this cemetery and visiting it and to my knowledge there has never been any toomstones as described above.

In a letter from Mrs. Norma Miller, Author of the above book, she states that "If our book is ever revised we will delete the cemetery information which you say is incorrect". In view of the above information from the cemetery records, Daury Allen # 17, could not habe been buried or ever lived in Pike County, Georgia.

Our Drury Allen from Orange County, N. C. to Pike County, Georgia is buried there as proved by the D. A. R. marker and documents of James M. Allen.

C. who is buried on adjoining property of mine, in response to your request from your book entitled: AILENS of the Southern States that if anyone has new information or has knowledge of erroneously presented information that you would be grateful if you were advised of such, so I would like to give you the following:

You state that Drury Allen (17) is a son of Robert Allen /1 and hes brothers Young, Josiah, Robt.

James Allen research shows, and I have documents to prove, that Lrery Allen was the SON of Young Allen #11 and had brothers, William (111), Robert 114, Moung 115, Coleman 117, Jesiah 118, and David 7110 as you have shown; however, you state that this Dreury Allen is not our Drury Allen of Orange County, N. C. but you attempt to prove our Drury Allen as a brother of Young Allen #11 instead and son of Robert #1. Our Drewy Allen, your #111, who married Elizabeth Yarbrough knk was born in Orang County, N. C. son of Young Allen. James Allen didnot attempt to carry Drewry Allen back any futher than Young as he could not document it.

You have our Drary Allen #17, married Elizabeth Yarbrough and their children listed correctly, but, as stated before, under the wrong ancestor, should be # 113.

I am enclosing a copy of the will of Young Allen dated 5th of Oct 1774 snowing his sons including Drury, we note in your book on page # 41 you have a copy of this will showing Young Allens sons EXCEPT for Drury.

I am enclosing document sheet of James M. Allen. If requested I will send you the documents and other information relating to our Drury Allen. I would like for them to be returned; however, you may copy if you desire.

In chapeter 8, page 169, first paragraph of your book you state Drury Allen and Elizabeth were both duried on their farm near Zebulon, Ga. and their graves are marked with toomstones which give the dates of their birth and deaths; however, there are NO marked graves for them, only the D.A.R. marker showing that Drury is buried in this plot and inscription:

Drewry Allen, N.C. Mil. Rev. War Born in Orange Co, N. C. Dec. 1, 1749 Died Jan. 20, 1828

It is unfortunate that James Allen died before he saw his work published. His brother Paul Allen had it published but he did not realize the importance of including all the documents to prove his research.

Dear Mr. Allen,

Thanks for your interest in our Allen book and for your thoughtful comments and suggestions.

Leaving Drury's name out of the will of Young Allen when it was copied for our book was an unfortunate typographical error. His name was, however, listed among the children of Young Allen on page 46 and it was noted that he was one of Young's legatees.

James M. Allen tried to find a connection between his Drury Allen of Greene and Pike Counties, Georgia and the Lunenburg County, Virginia families. He concluded that they were related although he did not find any documentation. I believe he would have been happy to see the records which did prove his point on that. I also believe Mr. Allen would have given careful consideration to the will in which "my son, Drury Allen" was named as the administrator of Robert Allen's estate and Drury's son, Josiah Allen, was bequeathed his grandfather's "home plantation." (pp. 26-30).

Mr. Allen made a logical conclusion about Drury being the son of Young Allen based upon the records he examined. In genealogical research, as with other subjects, the finding of new evidence frequently changes the conclusions to be drawn. Mr. Allen did a thorough and careful study and he did a beautiful job of presenting his Allen family in his book. The finding of new evidence in no way reflects on Mr. Allen or his family history.

All the Allen records we found were submitted to recognized genealogists and all of them concurred with our analysis of those records concerning the three Drury Allens of North Carolina. Descendants of all three of those Drury Allens were given DAR membership for that one payroll record in North Carolina.

If our book is ever revised we will delete the cemetery information which you say is incorrect. I'm sorry if that has caused you to be inconvenienced. They were a part of the DAR records.

Again, thanks for taking the time to share your opinions with us. We will pass them along to other interested family members.

Mrs. Sasser gives the following account on her application:

"Drewry Allen was born in Orange Co., North Carolina, Dec. 1st 1749. · He married Elizabeth Yarborough, who was born presamably in the same state, May 9, 1752. In 1776 he enlisted in the Continental Army and served until the close of the War. Drewry Allen served under Washington at the battle of Brandywine, and was with him at Yorktown, Va. He was also with Greene in the Carolinas at the battle of Cowpens and Guilford Court House. He used to tell his Grand children incidents of these battles. Once Greene sent him with a detachment to assist Marion in capturing a British force on the Great Pedee. They found the British feasting and ca rousing with some Tories. The patriots surrounded them and killed or captured the entire party; not one escaped. Grandfather used often to relate that one of the British soldiers, engaged in a game of cards, was found dead with the winning card clutched in his hand. After the War, Drewry Allen removed to Georgia, and settled in Greene Co. near Pullian's Factory, or Scull Shoals on the Oconee river. In 1824 he removed to Pike Co., Ga., where he died Jan. 20, 1826. His wife Elizabeth Yarborough, survived him two years. She died Feb. 20, 1828. After his death some of his comrades in arms came a long distance to weep overhis grave and relate to his grandchildren instances of the courage and patriotic devotion of their grandfather. One of these grandchildren, Robert H. Allen of Pike Co., Ga., still survives, and has a lively recollection of his graindfather.

Note: The above account was submitted to the DAR in 1903. Mrs. Sasser was notified by the DAR of her acceptance in October 1903. This account was signed by Carrie Ballard Sasser but the writing was not hers. It closely resembles that of another signature on the paper, that of the member who recommended her for membership; probably composed it for her.

IN MEMORIAM

DR. SIDNEY HALLECK YARBROUGH, JR.

1905 - 1954

with alarming swiftness our friends and associates are called from life unto death, and tonight we pause in memory of our departed brother and associate, Dr. Sidney Halleck Yarbrough Jr.

Ir. Yarbrough was born in our sister City of Montgomery; Alabama, on January 9th, 1905, of fine Presbyterian parentage, where he spent the early years of his life. After reaching manhood's estate, he enrolled as a student in the University of Alabama, and upon the completion of his studies there entered Emory University, where in 1932 he was awarded his Dental Degree

After graduation as a Dentist, he began the practice of his profession in Conyers, Georgia, later removing to Columbus, which afforded him a broader field for his splendid talents. It was in this city, on June 20th, 1934, that he married Martha Hays, whose charm and personality has endeared her to all of us. To this union, there was born two children, Sidney H. Yarbrough, III., and Martha C. Yarbrough, who survive him.

In the midst of a busy professional career, he heard the call to arms in World War II., and on February 7th, 1942, he enlisted in the armed forces of the United States, to which he gave unstintingly of his time and talents until his honorable discharge on March 31st, 1946, with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

Following his discharge from the army, he resumed his practice in this city, where he attained high rank, being recognized throughout this State and East Alabama as the leading Oral Surgeon in this area. In recognition of his ability, he was elected to membership in the Southeastern Academy of Oral Surgeons, in the Southeastern Society of Oral Surgeons, in the Georgia Dental Association and in the American Dental Association. He was also the shief of Dental Surgeons for Cobb Memorial Hospital, and of the City, and St. Francis Hospitals in this city, and a consultant for the State Hospital at Milledgeville, Georgia; and in further recognition of his ability, he was appointed by the Governor of this State as a member of the Board of Dental Examiners, which position he held at the time of his death. These are but a few of the well deserved honors conferred upon Dr. Yarbrough during his comparatively short career in the practice of his profession.

Dr. Yarbrough loved his profession, and regarded it as having no superiors among the professions. His ability and fine personality drew to him an increasingly large circle of friends and patients, for in the discharge of his professional duties he was rigid in the observance of honor and integrity, and was credited as being the full equal of the best in his profession, in which few have attained to greater success, and none, perhaps, possessed in greater measure than he the confidence, esteem and devotion not only of the fellow members of his profession, but of all with whom he came in contact, either in his profession or in his social life. To have left such a heritage of admiration, respect and esteem, unmixed with bitterness or strife, is not given to many.

STATE OF THE STATE

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while it is with pride that we have spoken of his outstanding professional career, there is yet another side to his character more precious in memory, -that is his Christian character, his high sense of honor, his devotion to his follow men, and his unselfish friendship, which permeated his very nature. Every sphere of endeavor in which he moved and wrought has, in his passing, suffered a distinct loss, for upon his record there is neither shadow nor stain.

During his residence in Conyers, Georgia, Ir. Yarbrough joined the Presbyterian Church in that city, and was elected to its Disconate, where his faithful services endeared him to all. Shortly following his removal to Columbus he was on September 10, 1935, received by letter into this Church. Later he served as President of the Men's Bible Class, and was on March 7, 1937, elected to the Disconate, and on February 24, 1946, was elected as a Ruling Elder, in which latter capacity he was serving actively at the time of his death. He was also an active member of the Young Men's Christian Association of this city, and of other organizations designed for the moral uplift and the promotion of the best interest of this community, in all of which he took an active part.

Dr. Yarbrough possessed the heart of the real Christian. In his affection for his family and friends he was loyal and true, and his soul grew as it mellowed and as the sum went down on his days. One of the greatest of all of his joys was the congenial compenionship of his devoted wife. Her splendid influence encouraged and strengthened his every high and noble purpose, and her constant and sympathetic devotion blessed him with a home of unalloyed happiness to the end of his days, and to her he graciously attributed a large portion of his success.

Dr. Yarbrough's faith and trust in God grew with his days, and he no doubt, like others, gained comfort and courage from the simple creed:

"I know but little; I believe much; I hope everything."

After having completed a difficult operation on the morning of June 11th, 1954, and almost without warning the final summons came, and while he loved life, yet he was not afraid to die, and met it with the same calm and assurance which had characterized his life, which was so quiet and unassuming that we know that in the calm and serener moments of his life he could freely join with Tennyson in that noblest death song ever written:

"Sunset and evening star,
And one clear call for me,
And may there be no mourning at the bar,
When I put out to sea.

For the from out our bourne of Time and Flace, The flood may bear me far, I hope to see my Pilot face to face, When I have crossed the bar."

His record was such, his belief and trust in God was so well grounded, that calmly and peacefully his soul quitted its earthly tabernacle for realms above. We can confidently believe that when his day was done and his work on earth was finished, he heard the soft and gentle voice of the lowly Mazarene saying: "Well done, thou good and faithful servant. Enter thou into the joy of thy Lord."

In his passing, we have lost a worthy example, a devoted friend and this Church a worthy and useful member.

To his devoted wife, to his fine young son and to his little daughter, we extend our deepest sympathy in their sorrow, and share with them the loss of one of God's noblemen.





president of the Ouachita Girl Scout Council.

"Marsha has been active in Boy Scouts with her sons," she added.

Randle Yarberry said that he has put many hours into the annual Girl Scout cookie sales, but was also involved with the Boy Scouts with their son Lee.

"I remember that Lee earned his Boy Scout Plumbing Badge by plumbing an 18-stall shower for me when we were building Camp Storey in the 60s," Randle said.

Yarberry was instrumental in the planning and construction of the camp, that is located on Lake Ouachita. "The purchase of the property was made in 1964, and in 1965 we had 11 Girl Scouts for camp with a portable generator, apartment range stoves, and buckets for washing dishes. In 1968 we had 600 girls from 13 states, which entailed 27,000 meals...I will never forget that number," he said."

The Yarberrys are also active in other organizations; she is the chairman of the First United Methodist Church's Hospitality Committee, is a member of the church's Recycled Voices, and serves on the Saline County Cancer Board. He has been active in the Lions Club since 1955.





MINUTES OF THE QUARTERLY COURT OF COCKE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, VOLUME I DEED BOOK E

"Be it remembered that at a Regular Quarterly term of the County Court of the County begun and held for the County of Cocke at the Court House in Newport approach to the first Monday in January 1877, it being the first day of said month at of the American Independence the One hundred and first year—

"Present and presiding W.W. Bibee, chairman, and the following other Justices to vit.—
C.E. Jones, J.J. Burnett, L.W. Merriman, J.S. Davis, J.A. Buckner, G.J. Thomas,
C.D. Fairfield, Wm Phillips, Joseph Rutherford, J.C. McNabb, Robert Mantooth, John Betler, Isaac Allen, Cary Denis, Daniel Hedrick, W.B. Allison, W.R. Harrison,
Abtery Fowler, John Ford and S.C. Berry,

When and where the following proceedings were held and entered of record to wit.

"It being this day suggested to the Court that on the morning of the 30th of December 1876. the Court House at Newport Depot in the County of Cocke was accidentally burned down with fire—
In which was burned all of the records and papers belonging to the office of clerk of the County Court and that nothing remains to refer to. the only source of information that can be obtained will be from the recollection of parties interested, memorandums they may have, and from the recollection of the different officers of said County—

"It being also reported to the Court that all of the Records & paper belonging to the office's of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, and Chancery Court of the County of Cocke, as well as all of the Records of the Registers office of Cocke County except Book N 17. were burned at the same time, as well as a part of the Records of the Entrytakers and surveyors office of the County." (p.1)

- "I The Court is pleased to Order and doth so decree, that all claims for and against the county be supplied with and from the best evidence that can be had.
- That the Tax Book for 1876 be supplied in the same way
- That all claims issued against the County be presented to the proper officers to be refiled and mimbered (numbered?),
- That the clerks of this court is required to make out as near as he can a Statement of all the unfinished business in the Court including a memorandum, of all the Petitions filed for the partition of Real Estate, whether for distribution or for partition with all of the orders made at each term of the Court in each case, as near as he can recollect
- That the clerk of this Court purchase all necesary Books for the use of all the different offices of this County, And that all the business done in the court from this time shall begin at No. 1. because all of the former numbers has been testroyed
- "6 That he make report as near as he can the result of any or of all of the settlements made with the different guardians for Minors.




